

CESC Player Protection Authorization Form

The Cape Express Soccer Club (CESC) is concerned with protecting the players of the Club. We are required to participate in the NJYS KidSafe Program to establish a minimum level of protection. In addition, the Board has decided to perform a criminal background check through the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.

The following persons involved with the CESC will need to comply with the program:

- Board of Directors
- Head Coach
- Assistant Coach
- Team Manager
- Trainers
- Any other individual who could be expected to be alone with any registered player for any length of time

Program compliance consists of the following:

1. Completing the NJYS Employment/Volunteer Disclosure Statement (the Statement)
2. Completing the CESC Player Protection Authorization Form that will allow the criminal background search (the Search) to be completed.

NJYS recommends that the Club President perform the duties of KidSafe Coordinator. The KidSafe Coordinator will keep the completed Statement and results of the Search in a secure location.

It is the intent of the NJYS KidSafe Program and the CESC to deny the ability to perform any of the above listed functions to any person who has been convicted of a crime of violence or a crime against a person.

I, _____, wishing to perform the CESC duties of _____, have read the above and in addition to completing the NJYS Employment/Volunteer Disclosure Statement, I also agree to allow the KidSafe Coordinator of the CESC to perform a criminal background check on myself. If necessary, I agree to comply with the decision of NJYS and the CESC Board as it relates to my ability to perform these duties based on my response to the Statement and the results of the Search.
